

CONFERENCE Details

Main Sessions

During main sessions at Encounter, your student(s) will hear from a variety of guest speakers on a range of topics. Each session will include live worship and a message rooted in God's Word.

Crews

Crews are designed to connect and engage students in life-giving relationships, leading them to dig into the truths shared during main sessions. They are the perfect environment to meet new friends. These age-specific groups will be broken up into middle school girls, middle school boys, high school girls, and high school boys. Crews will focus on strengthening and training students in discipleship, leadership, and evangelism. Each age group will be in a designated room and be facilitated by a Victory Family Church staff member or a trained Victory Family Church volunteer.

Meals

Your ticket to Encounter covers lunch and dinner on June 19 and 20. While we are unable to accommodate any food allergies or special meal requests, we are happy to refrigerate any food your student(s) needs to bring.

Safety

Our security team will be present in the building during the entire conference. Students will not be able to leave the campus at any time; our security team will monitor all exits. All volunteers for Encounter will be fully background-checked before they can serve. If you need to get in touch with your student(s) during conference and cannot reach out to them by phone, please call Victory Family Church at 724-453-6200.

Bags are subject to be searched upon entry. After a proper inspection, an exception will be made for items declared medically necessary.

FAQS

What should students bring?

We recommend students keep personal belongings to a minimum. However, sunscreen, a Bible, pen, and notebook are encouraged to be brought into the conference with them. Students will not need a change of clothes, swimsuit, or towel. Students are allowed bags that measure 12 x 12 in. or smaller, and/or medical bags.

What should students wear?

It's a youth conference! Students should dress modestly and in clothing they would be comfortable doing outdoor activities in. No swimsuits are needed.

Can students bring phones?

Phones are allowed, but we recommend leaving them home, so students can be fully present for everything God has in store for them!

My student needs medication during conference. What do I do?

We have nurses on site all day, every day! Labels for prescription medications will be available upon request. All prescription medications must be turned in to the nurse at registration on the first day. Our nurses are certified, and each nurse will make sure the students take their medication at the proper times. Please make sure the medicine is labeled with your student's name and medication information.

My student has a food allergy. What should I do?

We are happy to refrigerate any food that students need to bring to conference so that it is available to them during mealtimes.
