We can't wait to see your student at Encounter Conference next week. It's going to be three days of worship, fun, and spiritual growth. We know there is a lot to do to prepare for the conference, so we've compiled all the details for you.

Drop-Off Times:

Wednesday:

4:00 PM - All those who attend Victory Family Church or are NOT attending with a church group

5:30 PM - All those who are attending with a church group (excluding Victory Family Church)

Thursday & Friday:

9:00 AM - Everyone

All students will need to check in at the East Field Tents behind the church.

Dismissal:

Dismissal will vary by church and campus. Please reach out to your church or campus leader for more information.

General Dismissal Information:

Dismissal will begin at 8:45 PM each night. You will receive a text reminder each day letting you know where and when to pick up your student.

MIDDLE SCHOOL DISMISSAL - 8:45 PM

(5th-8th grade) will be picked up on the North side of the church (Car Shop side).

• Students in 5th and 6th grade will need to be picked up by an approved parent/guardian under the awning on the North side of the building.



HIGH SCHOOL DISMISSAL - 9:15 PM

(9th - 12th grade) will be picked up on the South side of the church (Sheetz side).



If you are picking up both Middle School and High School students, please pick them up on the North side of the building (Car Shop side).

Security:

For security purposes, no adults, except staff and registered leaders, will be permitted to enter the building.

Bag Policy:

Students are allowed bags that measure 12 x 12 in. or smaller, and/or medical bags. We will not be supplying bags this year.

Medication:

We have nurses on site all day, every day! Labels for prescription medications will be available upon request. All prescription medications must be turned in to the Nurses' Station tent on the first day. Our nurses are certified, and each nurse will make sure the students take their medication at the proper times. Please make sure the medicine is labeled with your student's name and medication information.

ID Badges:

At check-in, students will be given an ID badge. They are required to wear the badge for the entirety of the conference.
